***School Leadership Assessments for School Building Leader and School District Leader Part 1 SUBAREA 1 and Part 2 SUBAREA 1.** Four of the nine program completers have taken the state tests for School Building Leader and School District Leader. The remaining five program completers were grandfathered in by the state and were not required to pass the test prior to receiving certification. “The total test score for the School Leadership Assessments is reported on a scale of 100-300 with the passing score equal to a scaled score of 220” (*Annual Institution Results Report*, NYSTCE). The candidates’ total scaled scores in comparison with the statewide mean scaled scores for the SBL and SDL exams are displayed in the table above. The scores of three of the four candidates were above the statewide mean scaled score on the SBLP1 exam. Two candidates had scores above and two candidates had scores below the statewide mean scaled score on the SBLP2. For the SDLP1 exam, two candidates had total scaled scores above the statewide mean scaled score and one candidate had a score below. For the SDLP2 two candidates had scores above the statewide mean scaled score and candidate had a score below.

Each of the candidates who took the SBL and SDL exams passed.
